



Notice of Intent to claim personal super contributions

If you make a personal (after-tax) contribution to your super, you may be able to apply to claim a tax deduction on some or all of these amounts. This could reduce the amount of tax you pay for the year.

How to apply to claim a tax deduction

1. At the end of the financial year, complete this form and send it back to PSSap or ADF Super.
2. We will write back to you confirming your claim has been processed.
3. Use this information to lodge your income tax return.


Note: don't complete both forms.

When to apply

You can claim a tax deduction, provided you complete this form and receive a written response from us before you submit your tax return for the relevant year. We must have received your form by the earlier of either:

- the day you lodge your tax return for the year in which you made the contributions; or
- the end of the income year following the year in which you made the contributions.

Example



Julie must submit her claim for a tax deduction before the earlier of lodging her tax return and 30 June of the following financial year in which the personal contributions were made.

Am I eligible to claim a tax deduction?

You can claim a tax deduction for your personal contributions if:

- you have not opened an account-based pension using part or all of the contributions

- for which you intend to claim a tax deduction; and
- you're a member of PSSap or ADF Super and your contributions are still in your super account.

Can I change the amount I wish to claim as a tax deduction?

Yes. You'll need to complete section **C** of this *Notice of intent to claim a tax deduction for personal super contributions* form to reduce the amount claimed on your previous notice. If you don't want to claim any of your personal contributions, you'll need to reduce your claim amount to zero. Alternatively, you may want to provide a second notice specifying the additional amount you want to claim.
